The understanding of one's spiritual gift is a vital area in the life of a believer. Through a believer's knowledge of their spiritual gift, a believer can learn the spiritual purpose in which God has allowed them to be birthed into this world. A believer's spiritual gift is the special purpose God has established for them in which to minister to others and to be in service to the Father. A perfect example for beginning the understanding of the spiritual gift can be found in Jeremiah 1:1-10. This passage of scripture clearly lets the believer know God has a spiritual plan and purpose for your life even before you are placed in your mother's womb.

A person's spiritual gift can be discerned in childhood. A person's spiritual gift gives them a perspective of life from which they view the things of this world. One's spiritual gift may not be known or they have conflicted understanding about them as well may hinder you in service. Lastly, a person may not be walking in their spiritual gift as they are trying to spiritually someone else is gifted to be.
